Choosing the Right Program



Hardship Assistance

For employees or retirees facing unexpected life events that cause financial hardship.

Applicants should first explore other resources like personal loans or insurance

- Awards based on demonstrated financial need
- Assistance is typically provided as a one-time grant to help recover from difficult circumstances

Academic Assistance

For dependents of eligible employees or retirees pursuing postsecondary education.

- Awards based on demonstrated financial need
- Recipients receive scholarships and/or low-interest loans, renewable for up to 3 years (Typical application window: December-February)

Support available for trade, technical, vocational and traditional programs

What qualifies as unexpected hardship?

Serious illness, disaster, or family loss — <u>not routine</u> expenses or elective procedures.

What qualifies as financial need?

Need must be demonstrated beyond what can be covered through savings, loans, or family help.
